DAY 5 Thursday April 7


Breakfast, scuba diving departing from Kewalo Basin.
On-board lunch, then visit to Hawaiian Loko Pa'aiau fish pond to learn about sustainable and traditional aquaculture in Aiea. Dinner and live entertainment in Waikiki.

Breakfast, Kaneohe taro fields, lunch, expedition to Moku o Lo'e, Coral Nursery for lab work, snorkel at Coconut Island, farewell dinner, live entertainment, evening leisure at Waikiki.

DAY 2 Monday July 25

Welcome breakfast, drive to Key Largo, session on lionfish biology, ecology, collecting and handling. Two dives or snorkeling at Quiescence Dive Center with onboard lunch. Marine conversation session back at hotel, dinner and evening leisure.

DAY 3 Tuesday July 26

Eat breakfast, visit Mote in the Keys to see and discuss the coral restoration work, then eat lunch and enjoy afternoon leisure time, finishing with dinner at hotel.

DAY 4 Wednesday July 27

Breakfast and check out of hotel, transport back to Miami, collection of sea urchins, dive with Frost Science or Diver's Paradise vessel and urchin relation project with lunch. Check in to Miami hotel, marine conservation session in the afternoon, dinner and evening leisure.

DAY 5 Thursday July 28

Breakfast and visit 100 YOH for Restoration Day. Dive or snorkel from Diver's Paradise vessel to visit south Florida restoration site and continue relocation of sea urchins from previous day. Onboard lunch, marine conservation session, dinner and evening leisure.

DAY 6 Friday July 29

Breakfast, MUVE shoreline restoration project to remove non-native animals and plant Native species. Lunch, cultural exchange with guest speaker, marine conservation session, farewell dinner and evening leisure.

DAY 7 Saturday July 30

Farewell breakfast, short morning leisure with notes and debrief, followed by hotel checkout, shuttles to airport and flights back to the United States.

Breakfast, dive and snorkel at Cabo Pulmo, underwater visual surveys with lunch and snacks, afternoon dive/snorkel debriefing and data collection review. Dinner and evening leisure.

DAY 4 Wednesday November 17

Breakfast, dive and snorkel for underwater visual surveys and onboard lunch and snacks, community outreach activity in the afternoon. Ends with dinner with group, evening leisure for remainder of day.

DAY 5 Thursday November 18

Breakfast, check out of hotel and depart for beach town of La Paz. Check into hotel and stroll through town, followed by lunch in La Paz, and tour of town. Snorkel with whale sharks outside town of La Paz, return to hotel for dinner, evening leisure.

DAY 6 Friday November 19

Breakfast, community village exchange and habitat restoration, followed by lunch, afternoon leisure, with week ending with a cumulative debrief and farewell dinner.

DAY 7 Saturday November 20

Final farewell breakfast, ending notes and observations, followed by the hotel checkout and finally travel to airport for flights back to the United States.

DAY 3 Wednesday December 1

Snorkel or scuba at Cerralvo Island. Drift dive or snorkel over coral reefs and a superhighway of fish, explore for dolphins and whales. Whale shark researcher talk at night.

DAY 4 Thursday December 2

Breakfast, then whale shark snorkeling, lunch and discussion with the group, tour of beach town La Paz, ending with day debrief, dinner, and evening leisure.

DAY 5 Friday December 3

Snorkel or scuba at Cerralvo Island, dive a boulder field filled with swim-throughs and an ocean pinnacle. Explore field of Cortez garden eels and more blue water magic, then community service tree planting.

DAY 6 Saturday December 4

Breakfast, then on to SUP and shore snorkel lunch at resort, followed by authentic Mexican cooking class, farewell dinner with Mexican dance live entertainment.

DAY 7 Saturday December 5

Farewell breakfast, week debrief with notes and observations, then followed by hotel checkout and taking shuttles to airport back to the United States.
